A LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR

WHEN PEOPLE THINK OF SUPERHEROES, THEY THINK OF CAPES, POWERS, AND SECRET IDENTITIES. MANY HEROES WE SEE IN COMIC BOOKS HAD TRAUMATIC EXPERIENCES THAT FOREVER CHANGED THEIR LIVES.

IRON MAN'S PARENTS WERE KILLED IN A CAR CRASH.



SPIDER-MAN'S PARENTS DIED IN A PLANE CRASH.



BLACK PANTHER'S FATHER WAS MURDERED IN A BOMBING.



ALL OF THESE INDIVIDUALS TOOK THEIR TRAUMATIC EXPERIENCES AND CHANNLED THEIR INTENSE EMOTIONS INTO PROTECTING THEIR COMMUNITIES FROM EVIL.

THESE STORIES ARE VERY SIMILAR TO THOSE OF THE CHILDREN AT GLAD HOUSE, WHO HAVE LOST PARENTS DUE TO OVERDOSE, INCARCERATION, OR ADDICTION. IT'S OUR JOB TO TEACH THESE KIDS HOW TO DIRECT THEIR INTENSE EMOTIONS INTO MAKING THE WORLD A BETTER PLACE.

WE ALL HAVE THE CHANCE TO STAND UP FOR WHAT WE KNOW IS RIGHT, TO BE THE CHANGE WE'D LIKE TO SEE IN THE WORLD, AND TO SEE THAT THERE'S NOTHING STOPPING US FROM DOING THESE THINGS.

WEARING A CAPE IS OPTIONAL.

OUR KIDS HAVE BEEN THROUGH SO MUCH IN THEIR SHORT LIVES. THEY HAVE BEEN SEPARATED FROM THEIR PARENTS, LIVED IN POVERTY, BEEN SURROUNDED BY VIOLENCE, AND WONDERED WHEN THEY WILL GET THEIR NEXT MEAL. YET, DESPITE ALL THESE CHALLENGES, THEY KNOW THEY CAN BE SUPERHEROES BY BEING KIND, RESPONSIBLE, RESPECTFUL, BRAVE, STRONG, AND RESILIENT.

BECAUSE OF YOU, WE ARE CHANGING A GENERATION OF LIVES—TOGETHER.

GLAD HOUSE IS A SAFE PLACE WHERE THEY LEARN THEY CAN CHOOSE THEIR OWN PATH FREE FROM DRUGS. THEY LEARN THAT THEY CAN STILL LOVE THEIR PARENT AND HATE THE ADDICTION THAT HAS TORN THEIR FAMILY APART. THEY LEARN THAT THEY ARE NOT ALONE IN THEIR STRUGGLE, AND TOGETHER WE CAN BREAK THE CYCLE OF ADDICTION.

HOWEVER, WE NEED HELP FROM YOU TO BE ABLE TO PROVIDE ALL THE THINGS THESE CHILDREN NEED—YOU CAN BE A SUPERHERO FOR THESE KIDS, TOO! DUE TO THE TRAUMA THEY HAVE EXPERIENCED, THEY NEED A COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAM TO MEET THEIR NEEDS FOR EMPATHY AND MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT. THEY NEED PEOPLE TO BELIEVE THAT WITH THE BEST PROGRAM FOCUSED ON THEIR NEEDS, THEY CAN BE SUCCESSFUL IN LIFE.

GET THE FACTS

CHILDREN ARE THE MOST VULNERABLE POPULATION TO THE DEVASTATION OF THE DRUG EPIDEMIC.

THE LATEST RESEARCH SHOWS THAT ADDICTION DOES NOT EXIST IN A VACUUM—PARENTAL ADDICTION AFFECTS THE CHILDREN OF OUR COMMUNITY, SHAPING THEIR FUTURES BEFORE THEY CAN EVEN SPEAK.

SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER IS A BRAIN DISEASE WITH PEDIATRIC ONSET.

THIS MEANS THAT INDIVIDUALS DON'T SIMPLY CHOOSE TO BEGIN ABUSING SUBSTANCES IN ADULTHOOD. GENETIC AND BEHAVIORAL FACTORS HAVE BEEN IN PLACE SINCE THEY WERE CHILDREN, PREDISPOSING THEM TO THE ABUSE OF SUBSTANCES. CHRONIC STRESS CAN ACTIVATE DORMANT GENES, LEADING TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE ISSUES EARLIER IN LIFE.

CHILDREN WHOSE PARENTS HAVE A SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER ARE 4X MORE LIKELY (1 PARENT) AND 9X MORE LIKELY (BOTH PARENTS) TO DEVELOP A SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER IN ADULTHOOD.

FACTORS THAT CONTRIBUTE TO THOSE SPIKES IN RISKS ARE:
 GENETIC PREDISPOSITION
 NORMALIZATION OF DRUG USE
 DOMESTIC ABUSE
 FALLING BEHIND IN SCHOOL
 LACK OF DEVELOPMENTAL SKILLS
 INSECURE ATTACHMENTS
 TRAUMATIC EXPERIENCES

CHILDREN WHO TRY DRUGS BEFORE AGE 15 ARE 5X MORE LIKELY TO ABUSE DRUGS IN ADULTHOOD.

INTERVENING BEFORE FIRST USE IS CRITICAL TO PREVENT KIDS FROM USING DRUGS TO MANAGE STRESS, REDUCE SOCIAL ANXIETY, OR NUMB TRAUMATIC EXPERIENCES.

GLAD HOUSE'S COMPREHENSIVE CURRICULUM TARGETS CHILDREN'S PIVOTAL DEVELOPMENTAL STAGES TO TEACH THEM COPING SKILLS, EDUCATE THEM ON THE DANGERS OF DRUG USE, AND INSPIRE PASSIONS OUTSIDE OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE...

WHEN YOU WERE A CHILD, WHO WAS YOUR HERO?

MOM OR DAD?

CHILDREN OF ADDICTED PARENTS HAVE COMPLICATED FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS. DESPITE THEIR ADDICTIONS, MOST PARENTS STILL WANT MORE THAN ANYTHING TO BE THE BEST PARENT THEY CAN TO THEIR LITTLE ONES, AND THEY BATTLE EVERY DAY TO DO SO. SOMETIMES THEY WIN, SOMETIMES THEY LOSE.

AT GLAD HOUSE, WE TEACH THE KIDS ABOUT THE CHEMICAL IMPACT OF ADDICTION ON THE BRAIN. THEY LOVE LEARNING ABOUT SCIENCE! THE KNOWLEDGE HELPS THEM UNDERSTAND WHAT IS HAPPENING TO THOSE THEY LOVE, AND WHY ONE DAY THEY MAY HAVE A LOVING MOTHER, THE NEXT A COMPLETE STRANGER.

SOME OF OUR KIDS DON'T HAVE ANY PARENTS FIGHTING FOR THEM. WHEN THAT HAPPENS, GLAD HOUSE IS HERE TO PROVIDE A SAFE, STABLE PLACE AND LEADERS TO HELP THE KIDS LEARN THE POSITIVE DEVELOPMENTAL SKILLS THAT ARE USUALLY TAUGHT AT HOME.

RECENTLY, OUR KIDS WROTE LETTERS TO A "SUPERHERO" IN THEIR LIVES. SOME CHOSE THEIR MOM OR DAD. SOME CHOSE THE GRANDPARENTS WHO HAVE TAKEN THEM IN. MANY WROTE LETTERS TO A GLAD HOUSE STAFF MEMBER.

LIVING WITH AN ADDICTED CAREGIVER MEANS TAKING LIFE ONE DAY AT A TIME. GLAD HOUSE BUILDS RESILIENCY AND HELPS THE KIDS UNDERSTAND WHAT IS HAPPENING TO THEIR PARENTS. YOUR SUPPORT ENABLES US TO BE SUPERHEROES TO THESE KIDS, AND TO PRESERVE RELATIONSHIPS WITH THOSE THEY LOVE MOST.

DEAR MS. CRYSTAL:
YOU ARE A SUPERHERO TO ME BECAUSE YOU HELP ME GET THROUGH PROBLEMS AND SCHOOL WORK. I AM THANKFUL THAT YOU ARE MY THERAPIST AND HELP ME GET THROUGH PROBLEMS AT HOME. YOU HELP PEOPLE BE GOOD AND ENCOURAGE ME TO DO THE RIGHT THINGS.

DEAR GRANDMA:
YOU ARE A SUPERHERO TO ME BECAUSE YOU GAVE ME FOOD WHEN YOU DID NOT HAVE TO. YOU GIVE ME TOYS WHEN YOU CAN. YOU GAVE ME A ROOF. YOU TOOK CARE OF ME FOR 3 YEARS. YOU PUT CLOTHES ON MY BACK. YOU LOVED ME FOR A LONG TIME. YOU TAKE TIME FOR ME. THANK YOU FOR DOING WHAT YOU CAN.

DEAR MOM:
YOU ARE A SUPERHERO TO ME BECAUSE YOU HELP ME BE NOT AFRAID OF THE DARK. YOU KEEP ME SAFE. YOU SHOW ME POSITIVE THINGS. YOU HELP ME. YOU CARE ABOUT ME. I LOVE YOU.

DEAR MOM:
YOU PUT A ROOF OVER MY HEAD AND PUT FOOD IN MY STOMACH. YOU PUT EFFORT AND TIME FOR US. YOU TAKE US TO SCHOOL EVEN THOUGH YOU ARE VERY TIRED, AND A WAY I KNOW YOU ARE TIRED IS BECAUSE YOU TRY NOT TO FALL ASLEEP IN THE CAR WHILE YOU ARE DRIVING. AND I LIKE ALL YOUR LOVE BECAUSE YOU AND YOUR LOVE ARE VERY SPECIAL TO ME. AND YOU ARE VERY EDUCATED AND YOU KNOW MORE THAN ME. I AM TRYING TO BECOME LIKE YOU, BUT IT IS VERY HARD. BUT I AM TRYING, AND WHAT YOU SAID TO ME IS THAT TRYING IS THE ONLY THING THAT MATTERS.

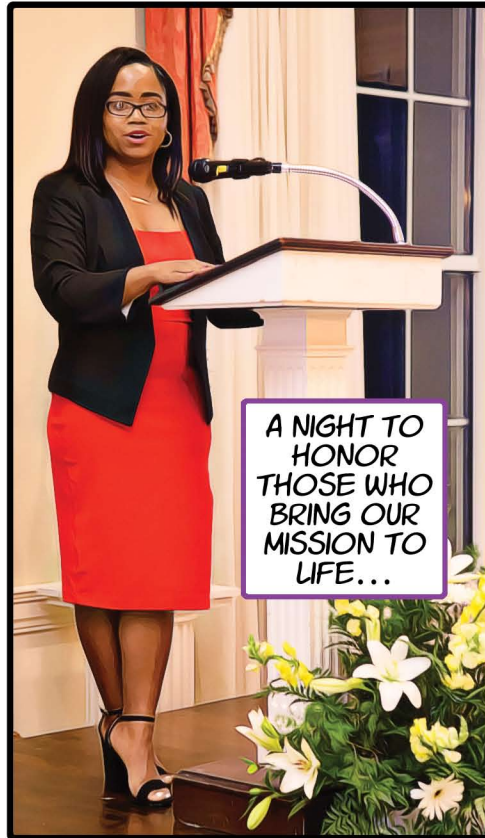
TWENTIETH ANNIVERSARY GALA

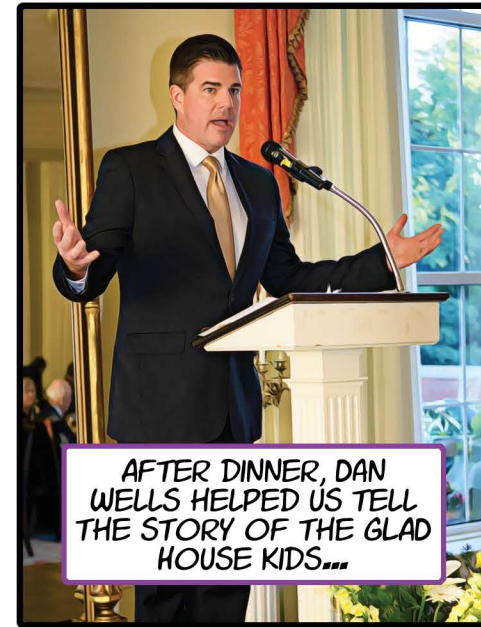

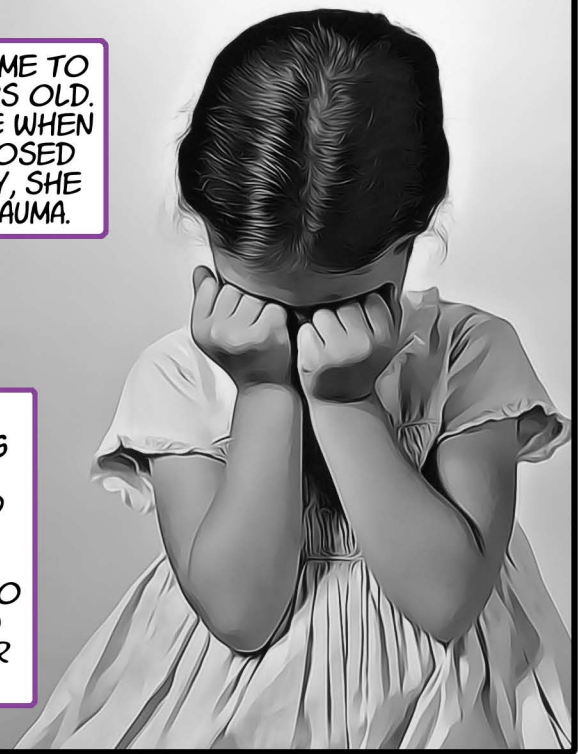


AFTER DINNER, DAN WELLS HELPED US TELL THE STORY OF THE GLAD HOUSE KIDS...

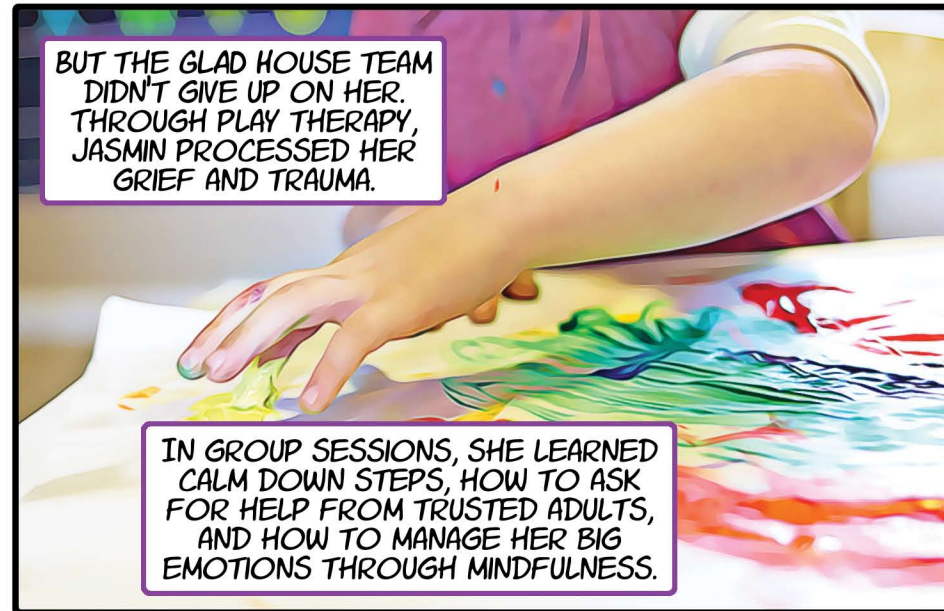

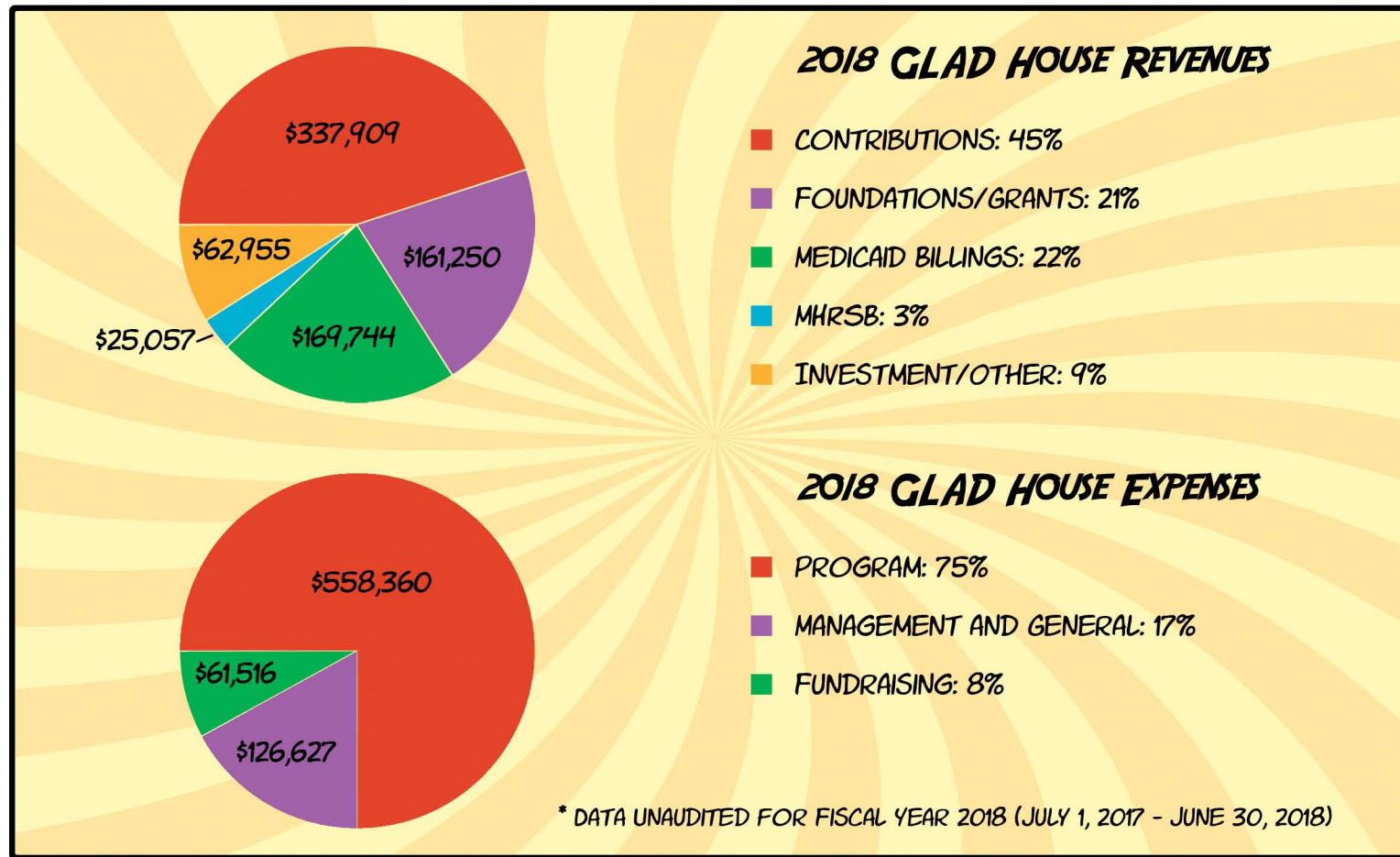
